Pre Registration

Entry: Entry fee of \$18.00 per wrestler. All wrestlers MUST have a current (2010) USA Wrestling athlete's card. All wrestlers MUST be pre-registered.

Admission Prices:

Adults - \$12 for all sessions, or \$6 – Friday, \$8 – Saturday, \$6 - Sunday

Students & Seniors - \$6 for all sessions, or \$3 – Friday, \$4 – Saturday, \$3 -Sunday

Coaches passes (\$10) will be sold at the Coaches Meetings Only – Friday at 3:30 pm, Saturday at 7:30 am and 1:30 pm

Individual Awards: Awards for 1st through 6th places

Rules: The rules of High School Wrestling with current USA Wrestling modifications where applicable will govern the event and the competition.

Uniforms: Singlets with underbriefs required, and the singlets should be predominantly one color. The use of headgear is **required** for Kids Divisions and permitted and encouraged for Cadets. All athletes with braces must wear mouth guards. Mouth guards are strongly recommended for all athletes.

Note: All athletes must weigh-in wearing a singlet.

Pairings: The top 10 Pee Wee, 20 Bantam, 25 Intermediate, 30 Novice and 3 Girls will be separated.

For Schoolboy and Cadets, we will have 3 levels of wrestlers that will be separated from each other, with priority going to Level 1, then Level 2 and then Level 3. All other wrestlers will fill in the blank spots in the bracket (randomly by the computer).

- Level 1 – wrestlers who placed 1st at the 2009 State Folkstyle Tournament in the same age group
- Level 2 - wrestlers who placed 2nd or 3rd at the 2009 State Folkstyle Tournament in the same age group
- Level 3 - wrestlers who placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd at the 2009 State Folkstyle Tournament in a different age group

All Age Groups: Wrestlers from the same **Sanctioned Clubs** will be separated from each other.

If you move up a weight from where you pre-registered at, you will lose your Level (you will not be separated).

Note: It may not always be possible to separate everyone in these criteria (depends on how many wrestlers are in the bracket).

Coaching: All Coaches must have a current (2010) USA Wrestling Coaches card. Coaches cards may be obtained through the MN/USA Wrestling website (www.mnusawrestling.org). Also, before you can get your Coaches Card, you must pass a background check (USA Wrestling policy). Please read the new [Coaching Etiquette at MN/USA State Tournaments](#) information located on the Coaches Corner page of our web site. Coaches passes (\$10) will be sold at the Coaches Meetings Only – Friday at 3:30 pm, Saturday at 7:30 am and 1:30 pm.
